

Bahrain International Circuit

Located in the heart of the Sakhir desert, Bahrain International Circuit is a unique and contemporary sports and entertainment venue that is synonymous with the highest levels of global motorsport. Featuring five different track layouts, the circuit first saw life in 2004 when the first ever Formula 1 Grand Prix took place in the country, making it the first-ever track in the Middle East to host the Formula 1 World Championship.

COMPETITION VENUE

Isa Bin Rashid Hall in Isa Town

Like culture, art and recreation, leisure and sports activities play an important role in communities. Their many benefits include improving the health and well-being of individuals, contributing to the empowerment of individuals, and promoting the development of inclusive communities.

The Kingdom of Bahrain boasts a wide range of sports activities and facilities that provide a full access platform for nationals and residents to lead a healthy and active lifestyle and also for tourists to enjoy. From motor racing to golf and equestrianism to football, the Kingdom caters to diverse sporting interests with an expansive selection of private and public Clubs and venues.

The state-of-the-art facility places Bahrain on the international sports map, enabling the Kingdom to host regional and international competitions. It also aims to help boost the sports movement in the country and create a generation of athletes capable of competing globally.

For the Manama 2025 Veteran Fencing World Championships, we will be installing 16 pistes for the preliminary, 8 color pistes, 1 podium for finals and 8 pistes for training.

The door is open to participants from November 10 to 20, 2025 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.



ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will start on the 10th of November and finish at the end of the World Championships. It will be held in the competition venue and according to the below schedule:

Days and Opening Hours

November 10 to 11	09:00-18:00
November 12 to 19	07:00-19:00
November 20	07:00-12:00

- Participants will not be allowed to use equipment control, the training venue, competition halls, or any other facility without accreditation.
- The head of the delegation can collect the accreditation showing proof of bank transfer or receipt of payment of the required fees and the passports of the participants.
- A personal photo of the accompanying persons or family of the athletes should be sent via email by October 10, 2025, at the latest.

PARTICIPATIONS

All participating athletes are required to have an FIE License, valid for the season 2024-2025 per the FIE Statutes and Administrative rules.

The registration of athletes and officials from the delegations must be done through the FIE website, www.fie.org, respecting the deadlines specified in the FIE Rules and the quotas of delegations. Photos of athletes and officials from the delegations registered on the FIE website must be uploaded on the FIE website. Also, entries must be sent to the organizers by the competitors' national federation. Entries must be sent no later than one month before the beginning of the championship.

ENTRY FEES

- Individual Registration Fees are 105 USD per fencer, per event,
- Team Registration Fees are 220 USD per team, per event.

ENTRY VISA

Important Information

- Visa requests will be processed online through the Organizing Committee.
- Visa fee will cost 70 USD per person

Visa Application Process

National Federations are advised to apply for their e-visa following this process:

Send an email to the organizing committee, attaching the following documents:

- A duly filled-out visa form. (<u>VISA FORM Veterans Fencing World Championships</u>, 2025 Manama, Bahrain) <u>Link</u>
- A clear copy of each delegation member's passport
- A recent passport photo of each member of your delegation saved with delegate and name (example: BRN_ athlete _last name _first name)
- Once visa processing is completed, the visa will be sent to the National Federation by email.

Deadline for visa applications: October 10, 2025

It is extremely important that all requests are received by the stated date to ensure that the required visas are obtained on time.

Any requests received after this date will not be accepted.

Please note:

Passports must be valid for at least six months beyond the date of entry into Bahrain.

Passport photographs should be taken over a white background with no glasses, hats, or accessories that may obstruct your face.

NATIONAL ANTHEM & FLAG

All the National Anthems that will be used during the FIE Veteran World Championships shall not exceed 75 seconds in length. They must be sent to the LOC, in addition to an image of the flag, at the email inquiriesvwcbrn@gmail.com before **October 25, 2025**.

When heads of delegation collect the accreditations, they will kindly be asked to sign a form to confirm that the anthem and flag emailed to us match the ones that will be used during the World Championships.

EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

All the equipment must comply with FIE regulations and will be checked under the control of the FIE SEMI commission. All fencers must have equipment compliant with the Material Rules of the FIE. It is mandatory to put the logos of the countries on both legs of the breeches. The surname of the athlete and the name of the country must be printed on the back of the jacket and/or electric jacket. All advertising and manufacturer logos must be in conformity with the FIE Publicity Code requirements and will be checked. For additional information, please see Material Rules of the FIE.

TRANSPORTATION

We are providing transport buses from the airport to hotels for participants who will be residing at our official hotels during the event.

This will cost about **100 USD per person** (airport - hotel - airport) (Hotel - sports Venue - Hotel)

How to reserve transportation:

- Fill out the reservation form and submit it via email (<u>Hotel and Transport Booking Form -</u> FIE Veterans World Championships, 2025 - Manama, Bahrain) - LINK
- The team will review your reservation
- If accepted, we will send you an invoice for payment
- Make payment via bank transfer (in USD)
- Cash on arrival is accepted if the delegation experiences difficulties making bank transfers.
- Please note: Competition venue transportation is guaranteed only if you stay at official hotels
- In case of any change of transportation details by the participants less than 48 hrs. before the transportation date, service will not be guaranteed.
- The Transport reservations must be made before **October 20, 2025**.
